Before his time on the Hill, Jerr practiced law at one of Washington, D.C.'s oldest firms and clerked for U.S. District Judge Jackson Kiser, contributing to cases that reached the U.S. Supreme Court. He has also held positions with Senator John Warner and the Virginia Attorney General's Office.
